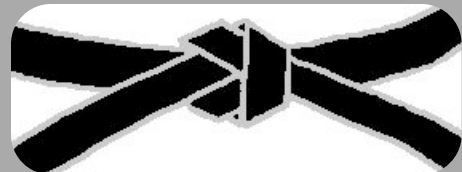


Black Belt Ceremony
